Shotgun-see footnote	Apr 1-Oct 31	10	All shooting equipment, clays and ammunition provided. 1 adult/8youth ratio required (minimum of 2 adults.) Person holding a BSA Range Director card, NRA Range Director card or equivalent military certification must be on-range throughout use of the ran
BB Gun	Apr 1-Oct 31	5	All shooting equipment and ammunition provided. 1 adult/2youth ratio required (minimum of 2 adults.) Council approved Range Officer must be on hand throughout use of the range. Range Officers available by contacting Rob Sparks at 767-7126. Personal firearms are not permitted.

¹ Black-out periods apply due to Council sponsored events for both Scout groups and non-Scout groups. District and Council event planners should incorporate these fees when calculating their event costs for Klondike Derbies, Camporees, Camporalls and other events.

² At the discretion of the Camp Ranger, the Turner Building may be used as an overnight facility for Scout Groups only, but is not reservable as such. The overnight rate, if authorized, is \$150 per night. Likewise, Cedar Lodge is available at the Ranger's discretion for \$50 per night.

³ Rustic Cabins are located in Dan Boone, Kit Carson, Wyandot and Blue Jacket campsites and feature a heating stove for winter camping.
