Flexible/Open Scheduling

For 2010 we are moving to Flexible/Open scheduling in several program areas, namely: Nature/Ecology, Outdoor Skills, Aquatics, and Handicraft. Flexible scheduling is designed to meet the needs of individual scouts. It will allow for a scout who needs to take more time and have more instruction to receive the individual attention he needs, while the scout who is more familiar with the subject matter and/or more motivated can move quickly through the requirements and have time to start a second Merit Badge mid-week in the same time slot. It meets the needs of the scout who likes to work at his own pace, while still allowing you to build a schedule for the scout who does better with more structure. It also allows us to offer a wider variety of merit badges to fuel the interest of your returning scouts.
