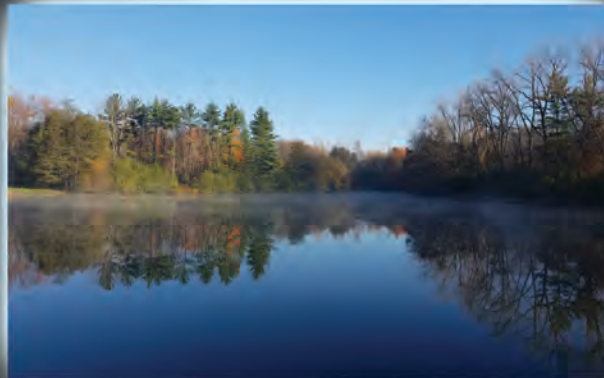

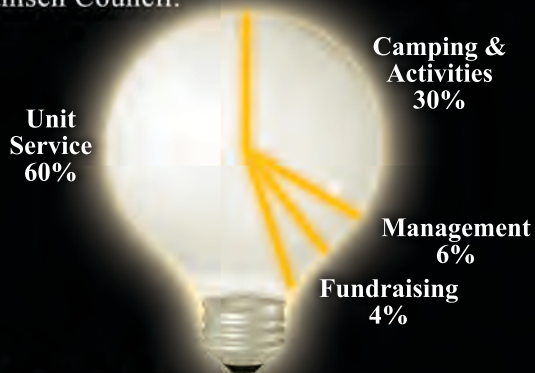

Expenses

It costs \$205 a year to support each Scout in the Tecumseh Council.



Unit Service 60%

- Scout Service Center and Scout Store
- Training courses and monthly Roundtable meetings for Scout leaders
- Marketing materials (flyers, posters, yard signs and wristbands) for recruiting new members
- Processing of registration, training and advancement records
- Email blast, council website and mailings
- Volunteer and Scout recognition awards
- Dedicated field and support staff to serve Scout leaders and parents

Camping & Activities 30%

- Camp Hugh Taylor Birch (costs \$300,000 per year to operate and maintain)
- Camporees, Klondike Derbies, Spook-O-Ree, Family Bash
- Camperships for Scouting families with financial need
- Events such as Dayton Dragons lock-in and merit badge clinics
- Scouting for Food, Eagle Scout Recognition Luncheon

Council Highlights

Tecumseh Council is ranked as one of the top 5 Boy Scout Councils in Journey to Excellence.

89 boys earned the Eagle Scout Award.

128 Webelos earned the Arrow of Light.

The Tecumseh Council serves over 3,400 youth members.

More than 1,400 adults serve Scouting as positive role models for youth in our community.

Over 4,000 Scouts and adults collected more than 45,000 items of food to feed the hungry of Logan, Champaign, Clark, Greene and Clinton Counties.

More than 24,000 hours of community service were volunteered by Scouts and leaders.

Over 600 youth attended summer camp at Camp Birch participating in DARE, Challenge Camp, Tecumseh Island, Mad River Trace and more.

Over 2,000 Cub Scouts attended various summer camps and events at Camp Birch.

Over 16,000 campers used Camp Birch in 2017.

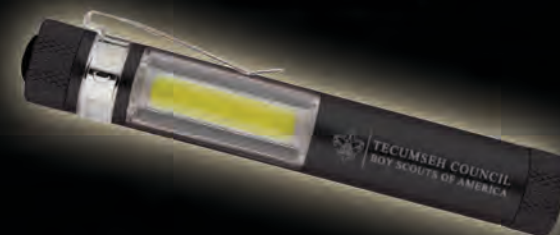
Improvements at Camp Birch included replacing decking on the bridge by the Dining Hall, building a new rifle range and renovations to the pool.
