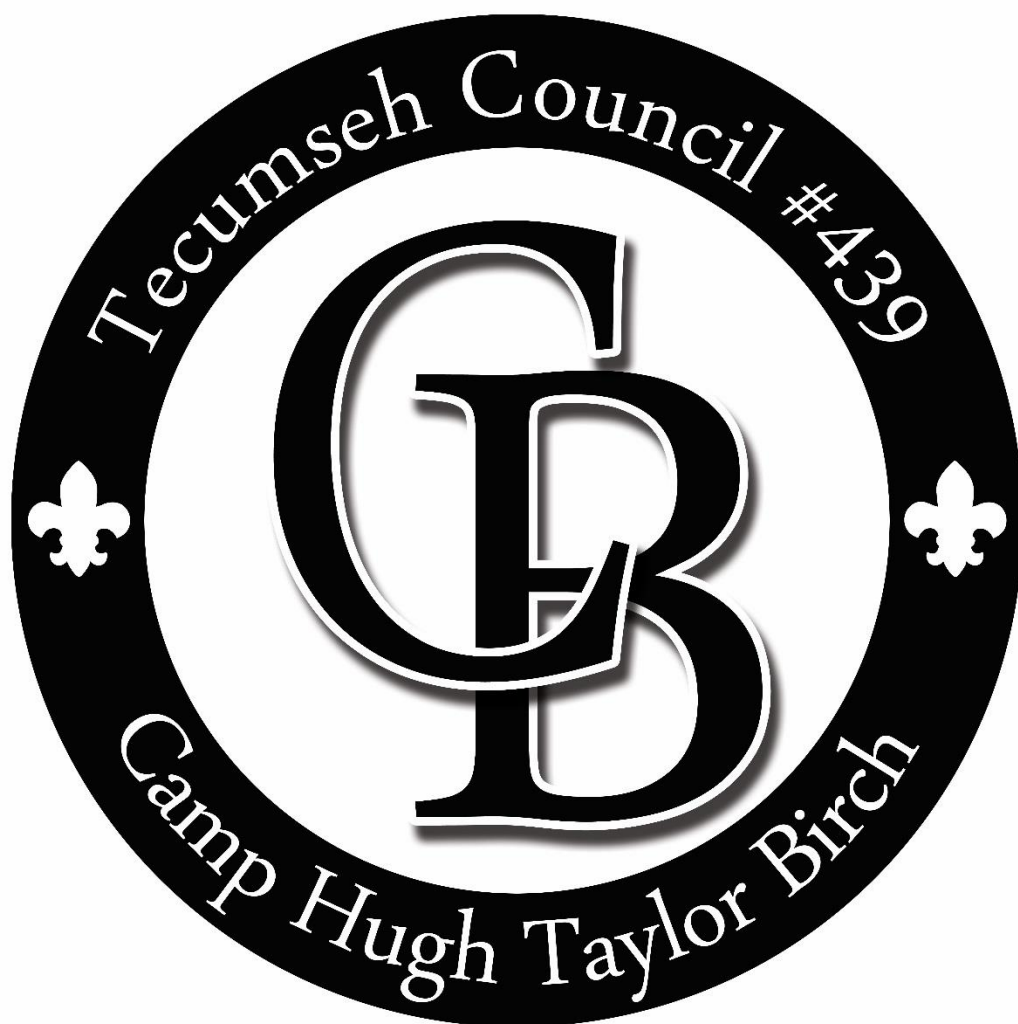

Position Descriptions

Counselor in Training

Camp Birch has a Counselor in Training program that is a true training program. CIT's attend Staff Weekend if possible as well as Staff training week. CIT's work camp on a rotating basis each week. Please select Counselor in Training if you are interested in the CIT program. This application must be submitted by May 1st.

Instructor

An instructor is a position that is available in all areas of camp. It is required to be able to teach the participants and younger staff members about Scout Skills, and the workings of CHTB. Those that apply to be an Instructor should expect to work towards being an Area Director, to achieve more responsibility and gather important career skills. Please submit the application for this position by May 1st.

Area Director

As an Area Director, it is your responsibility to plan the lessons, be familiar with the material, and also know what to do in times of Medical Emergency. Eagle Scouts, those in professional teaching fields, veterans, or past camp staffers are very likely candidates. Be advised that this position requires a lot of time and dedication to plan. Code of Ethics for Camp Staff

Boy Scouts of America Declaration of Religious Principle

The Boy Scouts of America maintains that no member can grow into the best kind of citizen without recognizing their obligation to God, and therefore, acknowledges the religious element in the training of the member, but it is absolutely nonsectarian in its attitude toward the religious training. Its policy is that the organization or institution with which the member is connected shall give definite attention to his religious life. Only persons willing to agree with this declaration of principle and the Bylaws of the Boy Scouts of America shall be entitled to certificates of leadership.

Scout Oath and Law

The Camp Birch Staff, like all Scouts, is expected to abide by the Scout Oath and Law:

Scout Oath or Promise

On my honor I will do my best to do my duty to God and my country and to obey the Scout Law, to help other people at all times, and to keep myself physically strong, mentally awake, and morally straight.

Scout Law

A Scout is Trustworthy, Loyal, Helpful, Friendly, Courteous, Kind, Obedient, Cheerful, Thrifty, Brave, Clean and Reverent.

Other Items

All Camp Staff members must be registered with the Boy Scouts of America. If you are not currently registered with the BSA, doing so will be a condition of employment. In compliance with the Civil Rights Act, Tecumseh Council will not deprive individuals the use of employment, programs, or facilities based on national origin, race, creed, color, sex, age, or handicap provided they meet other eligibility requirements.
